Amendment to the Tuality Healthcare Medical and Prescription Drug Plans Plan Document and Summary Plan Description (restated January 1, 2007).

MEDICAL BENEFITS, COVERED CHARGES, Item (i). The current provision in the plan document is stated as follows:

- (i) Rental of **durable medical or surgical equipment** if deemed Medically Necessary, and when preauthorized. See Utilization Review provision under the Medical Management Services section. These items may be bought rather than rented, with the cost not to exceed the fair market price of the equipment at the time the equipment is purchased, but only if agreed to in advance by the Plan Administrator. If the equipment is purchased, the purchase price will be prorated over a 12-month period, subject to benefits and eligibility. If the person purchased the equipment and the rental price would have been less or the necessary information was not provided, the Claims Administrator will only allow what would have been paid had the equipment been rented rather than purchased.

MEDICAL BENEFITS, COVERED CHARGES, Item (i). The current provision as listed above is amended as follows:

- (i) Rental of **durable medical or surgical equipment** if deemed Medically Necessary, and when preauthorized. See Utilization Review provision under the Medical Management Services section. These items may be bought rather than rented, with the cost not to exceed the fair market price of the equipment at the time the equipment is purchased, but only if agreed to in advance by the Plan Administrator. If the equipment is purchased, the purchase price will be prorated over a 12-month period, subject to benefits and eligibility. However, the 12-month prorated period stated above does not apply to bone stimulators. The entire covered benefit for bone stimulators will be paid to the service provider once the claim has been submitted and processed. Utilization Review pre-approval needs to be obtained as these stimulators generally exceed the \$500 threshold for durable medical equipment which requires prior approval from Medical Management. If the person purchased the equipment and the rental price would have been less or the necessary information was not provided, the Claims Administrator will only allow what would have been paid had the equipment been rented rather than purchased.

By this Amendment, the Tuality Medical and Prescription Drug Plans Plan Document and Summary Description is hereby amended effective January 1, 2007.
